
Memorandum of Understanding for Limited Access 2022

This Memorandum of Understanding for Limited Access 2022 ("Agreement") is between the Huron River Hunting and Fishing Club, a Michigan not for profit corporation ("HRC") and Farmington Glen Aquatic Club, Inc., a Michigan not for profit corporation ("FGAC") (HRC and FGAC each a "Party" and collectively the "Parties").

WHEREAS, HRC operates a paid membership private dining club available to its members and guests;

WHEREAS, FGAC operates a paid membership private seasonal swim club for its members and guests; and

WHEREAS, FGAC and HRC deem it advisable and in the best interest of their respective membership to offer a limited use of their respective clubs to the members of the other club on the terms and conditions below, and as may be modified from time to time due the Covid 19 pandemic:

1) Limited Use of FGAC Facilities by HRC Members:

- a) With advanced reservations, HRC members may attend:
 - i) Open House for new members welcoming event;
 - ii) Scheduled events or parties, except as excluded below;
 - iii) Ladies Night;
 - iv) Adult Swim Nights;
 - v) Farmington Glen 60th Anniversary Celebration
 - vi) Swim Lessons.
- b) HRC members may not attend the following FGAC events:
 - i) Memorial Day Summer Kickoff and BBQ;
 - ii) 4th of July Family Picnic;
 - iii) NSSL Swim meets (3 dates per summer);
 - iv) Fun and Floatables Nights; and
 - v) Labor Day Last of Summer Potluck.
- c) HRC members and spouse can attend the events upon payment of a \$25 program fee (which includes first time pass for two) where upon they will receive a fob for access to the FGAC grounds. Thereafter, access for HRC members and guests shall be at a flat \$10 per HRC member and guest or \$35 per family. For attendance at special FGAC events, the charge for HRC members and guests shall be the same admission price as charged to FGAC

members and guests. All Goods and services charged by FGAC to HRC members and guests shall be paid in cash at the time the services and goods are provided.

- 2) Limited Use of HRC Facilities by FGAC Members: FGAC members and their spouses and guests are invited to use HRC facilities as Reciprocal Guests at such times and during such events as approved by HRC management consistent with the HRC's Reciprocal Usage Policy. All FGAC members contacting the HRC for reservations shall identify themselves as a FGAC Reciprocal Guest. Dining is Tuesday through Saturdays. Specials and information can be found at www.huronriverclub.com
- 3) Use of the respective clubs is governed by a dress code. Each club shall advise its members of the dress code required by the other club as a condition to the limited access afforded by this Agreement.
- 4) Adjustments: HRC and FGAC both acknowledge that the respective primary obligation is to their respective memberships. Therefore, each Party agrees to negotiate in good faith regarding mutually agreeable modifications to this Agreement and this Agreement may be terminated by either Party on 30 days written notice whenever practical for any reason or no reason and may be amended upon such reasonable notice as necessary due to the Covid 19 pandemic. Any deviation from the restrictions contained herein are subject to approval by management of the respective Clubs.
- 5) Each party shall assist the other in resolving any payment dispute between its members and the club providing limited access pursuant to this Agreement.
- 6) Any announcement disseminated by a Party promoting this limited reciprocal use shall be approved in advance by the Board Directors of the other Party (e.g., FGAC's use of a flyer announcing this program by describing the terms of use and availability of HRC amenities to FGAC members shall be approved in advance by the HRC Board of Directors).
- 7) Term. This agreement shall be effective for 2022 only, and thereafter extended upon the mutual written approval by the Boards of Directors of both Parties.
